# NOTICE OF RACE

2010 Great Atlanta Blowout - April 30 – May 2, 2010

**Dates:** April 30<sup>th</sup> – Registration / Happy Hour  
May 1<sup>st</sup> – Registration/Racing / Dinner  
May 2<sup>nd</sup> – Racing

**Venue:** Lake Lanier Sailing Club 6206 Commodore Drive, Flowery Branch Georgia 30542

---

**Rules:** The Great Atlanta Blowout will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, the Rules of the International Melges 24 Class (M24 fleet), the rules of the International Flying Tiger 10M class (FT10 fleet), the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

---

**Eligibility:** Melges 24 Class boats qualified per obligations of the M24 Class Rules and National Authority.  
Flying Tiger 10M Class boats qualified per obligations of the FT10 Class Rules and National Authority.

---

**Entry Fee:** \$95.00 – Payable through RegattaNetwork Online Registration: <http://tinyurl.com/GreatAtlantaBlowout>  
Includes Regatta Racing, and 4 meal tickets for Saturday dinner (Extra meal tickets can be purchased for \$10 during online registration)

---

**Scoring:** Regatta Scoring - the Great Atlanta Blowout regatta will be scored as governed in appendix A of the racing rules, using the low points system.  
Melges 24 Fleet Series Scoring – points will be awarded according to the *Melges 24 Southeast Scoring Policy*.

---

**Alternative Penalties** RRS 44.1 shall apply except that the Two-Turns penalty is modified to be a One-Turn penalty

---

**Sailing Instructions** Will be handed out during registration.

---

**Liability:** The Safety of the boat and crew shall be the sole responsibility of the boat's owner and/or owner's representative. Skipper and crew assume the risks of racing and agree not to sue race administrators. Skipper is responsible for conduct of crew.

---

**Dockage & Launching:** Provided by Lake Lanier Sailing Club, included in registration fee. Boats may use the Lake Lanier Sailing Clubs launching ramp, and may dock overnight both Friday and Saturday using the outside (opposite ramp side) of the Dock located at the front entrance launch ramp, or other designated docks.

---

**Lodging:** 1) Camping: LLSC camp sites will be made available to regatta competitors and their family beginning 12pm Thursday, April 29<sup>th</sup> until 7pm Sunday, May 2<sup>nd</sup>.
